

Has My Child Reached Compulsory Age?

Was your child 6 prior to July 1st (or will he be)?

YES



Your child has reached compulsory age and you will need a Notice of Intent on file at your county office before homeschooling this school year. Additionally, your child will need assessed (using 1 of 4 options) each year you homeschool.

Has your child ever been enrolled in a publicly-supported preschool or kindergarten? (Don't include private school enrollment.)

Your child is not yet of compulsory age. You may homeschool this year without a Notice of Intent or assessment. However, it might be prudent to turn in a notice and do an assessment for kindergarten **if** you are considering enrolling in public school for 1st grade.
