

Concord University Courses for High School Students

Concord University would like to invite home school students in Mercer and Raleigh Counties to consider taking college-level coursework and receive either high school credit and/or college credit.

A limited number of General Education classes will be made available for qualifying students for a cost of twenty-five dollars per college credit. While no more than two classes per semester are recommended, students will be able to take two classes each semester at this greatly reduced per credit cost.

The classes will be delivered by Concord faculty either asynchronously or synchronously as either a face-to-face session on the Athens or Erma Byrd Campus in Beckley or via Zoom due to the COVID-19 pandemic. If students register for a hybrid section (designated with a numeral and HW), they must be able to attend class on the designated campus at the specified time.

Interested students must complete an <u>application</u> and be admitted to Concord University as a non-degree seeking student in order to register for classes. Course registration occurs on a first-come, first-serve basis so the sooner a student is admitted, the sooner he/she can be registered for spring classes. Please note that a class may be closed by the time the student is admitted and eligible to register. Classes for Spring 2021 classes begin on Tuesday, January 19, 2021.
